STAFF GEAR

Gear for training - Check with the trainer to bring any additional gear

- Sleeping bag (*winter bag must have a -20°F or better rating*) \$30.00 for +20°F/\$38.00 for -20°F
- Poncho (*additional lightweight wind jacket*) \$14.00
- Ground pad \$7.00
- Journal and pen \$1.00
- Stuff sack (*for food*)
- Fanny pack or carrying pouch \$11.00
- Two 1 liter water bottles \$5.00
- Two bandannas or wash rags \$0.50 ea.
- One pair of long pants (*Denim jeans discouraged*) \$20.00
- One pair of shorts (*summer*) \$17.00
- One T-shirt (*summer*) \$2.00
- Baseball cap and beanie \$5.00
- Fleece hoodie or sweater \$15.00/\$11.00
- 4-6 pair of socks (*avoid cotton*) \$5.00 -\$7.00 ea.
- Two pair of underwear \$2.00 ea.
- Hiking boots or comfortable hiking shoes (*Broken in*) and sandals or chacos (*if desired*)
- Comb or brush \$0.50/\$2.00
- Lip balm or chapstick \$1.50

- Cooking pot w/lid (*avoid Teflon*) 24 oz. or larger \$13.50

- (*winter*) Long underwear \$10.00
- (*winter*) Long-sleeve shirt or thermal \$10.00

- Sandals or flip flops (*for walking around camp*)

Food and water are provided

Do Not Bring Following Gear Until Training Has Been Completed:

- Knife (*lock blade or sheath knife*)
- Compass / GPS / Map / Sunglasses
- Small flashlight or head lamp
- Watch or thermometer
- Butane lighter
- Extra food
- No toothpaste, soap, hair care products or deodorant

Notes on What to Avoid:

- No piercing of any kind allowed in the field (*to avoid infection*)
- No jewelry other than a wedding ring (*although jewelry made by hand is acceptable*)
- No contact lens worn out in the field during training (*though after training it is acceptable*)
- No dreadlocks, hair care products or deodorant

The following items will be provided:

soap, toothpaste, vitamins, electrolytes, pens, sunscreen, after-sun cream, lotion, hand sanitizer, medical necessities, water treatment, food and water.
